Race Restrictions: NO BELOW 9th grade runners
No runner currently in your varsity's top 7 are allowed to compete.

Entry Procedures: Please complete both steps by **Sunday, October 13, 2019 at midnight.**
1. Enter **competing** athletes on Direct Athletics.
2. Email the names of your current **varsity** top 7 to mskidds@coebrown.org.

Distance: 5000 meters (3.1 miles) (Coe-Brown Cross Country Course)

Results: Computerized results as in the championship meets posted on www.newhampshirecrosscountry.com, and www.directathletics.com

After the JV State meet it is possible that one or more of the JV State Meet runners could replace a varsity runner in the class meet because of their performance in the JV State meet. There is no restriction about listing or running any of these athletes in the Class Meet or Meet of Champions. At the same time, please keep in mind this is meant to be a JV state championship and only your current JV runners should be competing.
